Sale Catalogues in Reading Central Library

When a house or land is put up for sale, commonly by auction, a document is produced detailing the property. In the Local Studies Collection we have over 4000 Sale Catalogues for buildings and property across the old County of Berkshire and quite a lot of Oxfordshire too.

These can be useful in many ways, most obviously for a house history, showing exactly what the property was like at that time (sometimes including the rent you could expect to pay). They can also be used to show the changes that took place over a period of time, this is more so in the case of major properties such as Whiteknights Park, where we have the details of more than one sale, and it also reflects the fortunes (or lack thereof) of the owners.

Some of the early ones in the collection are:
